Dear Competitor,

Congratulations on being selected to represent your Province at the 2010 National Music Festival. I look forward to meeting you in Montreal, Quebec.

The competitions will be held August 13th – 15th at McGill University in Montreal. Arrangements will be made for you to stay in residence at the University.

Travel costs are the responsibility of the competitor and/or your Provincial Association. Your travel arrangements must be made in consultation with your Provincial Administrator who will be handling the coordination. You and your accompanist will arrive in Montreal on Wednesday, August 11th (or Tuesday, August 10th if connections do not allow you to be there in time for the briefing session Wednesday evening) and be taken by a volunteer to the campus. Again I must stress, **ALL ARRANGEMENTS MUST BE MADE THROUGH YOUR PROVINCIAL ASSOCIATION SO THAT TRAVEL CAN BE COORDINATED**. Please remember that all accompanist expenses are your responsibility. If you are driving, please note – there is no parking at McGill.

Attached are three forms: INFORMATION AND TRAVEL FORM, BIOGRAPHICAL PROFILE AND MEDIA FORM and WAIVER FORM. All of the forms must be completed and returned to your Provincial Festival Office before **June 20**. Please be sure that separate forms are completed for **each** member of the Chamber Group. When listing your repertoire (your provincial administrator has this form), please be specific. Include the **names** of movements and the order of performance. Remember, you want your listing to be correct in the program. You have a maximum of **ONE** hour of stage time including set up, your performance, any breaks, tuning, applause etc.

The other enclosed materials and the Regulations in the Syllabus must be read carefully and complied with.

In July you will be sent a schedule of events and on arrival you will receive rehearsal and performance information as well as other important information.
